

PPC Meeting 8-17-15

The PPC met Monday, August 17, 2015. The meeting was called to order at 2:32 p.m. with Sean Fletcher, Pam Buel, Jessica Palmer, Hannah Shipman, Cindy Martin, Tammy Starkey, and Mr. Wes Henderson, Superintendent, in attendance.

Officers were elected for the 2015-16 school year as follows: Sean Fletcher, Chairperson, with Pam Buel nominating and Hannah Shipman seconding. Tammy Starkey, Secretary, with Jessica Palmer nominating and Pam Buel seconding.

The group was presented with a packet including Personnel Policies requirements, a copy of our PPC guidelines and proposed changes, and the Y-S District certified benefits, by Sean. The committee reviewed the PPC guidelines and it was decided to amend the wording of the Y-S policy from 9 members to 8; Four teachers from K-6 and four from 7-12 grade levels, plus 2 principals and the Superintendent of schools. Another change is to change the length of the terms served from 3 years to 4.

The committee reviewed the district's personnel benefits in order to remain aware of what we would like to be working towards as soon as it is feasible. Mr. Henderson is supportive of adding back to the employee benefits as we are released from the state's financial distress plan.

Sean brought up the idea of some type of incentive program to encourage teacher attendance. Mr. Henderson stated that anything requiring money would have to be approved by the state, but it is certainly an idea worthy of research.

Jessica made a motion to adjourn, Sean seconded and the meeting was adjourned at 3:03 p.m.
