Limitations & Disclaimers

- Wireless access is provided as a public service free of charge on an as-is basis with no guarantee and no warranty. The Yellville-Summit School District's Wireless network is subject to periodic maintenance and unforeseen downtime.
- Information passing through the Yellville-Summit School District's wireless access is not secured and could be monitored, captured, or altered by others. There are risks involved with connecting to a public wireless connection, such as possible viruses, malware, loss of data, possible hacking/snooping by others connected, possible hardware/software failure. It is your sole responsibility to protect your information from all risks associated with using the Internet, including any damage, loss, or theft that may occur as a result of your use of the Yellville-Summit School District's wireless access.
- All Wi-Fi users should have up-to-date antivirus software installed on their computers.
- The device owner is responsible for setting up their equipment to access the Yellville-Summit School District's Wireless network. Yellville-Summit School District staff is not trained to handle your specific device or peripheral equipment. Yellville-Summit School District staff may attempt to help with configuring users' devices, and will provide only general assistance in getting connected to the wireless network.
- The Yellville-Summit School District assumes no responsibility for the safety of equipment; users must keep their equipment with them at all times.
- In using this free Internet access, you agree and hereby release, indemnify, and hold harmless, the Yellville-Summit School

- District, its officers and employees, and any affiliate, from any damage that may result from your use of this wireless access.
- While using this wireless access, you acknowledge that you are subject to, and agree to abide by all laws, and all rules and regulations of the Yellville-Summit School District, The Arkansas Department of Education, the State of Arkansas, and the federal government that is applicable to Internet use.
 - At its sole discretion, the Yellville-Summit School District may terminate this public service at anytime without prior notice.
 - Printing is not available via the public wireless connection at this time. If the user desires to print, the file can be saved to a flash/thumb drive or emailed to themselves and printed from a computer in the Computer Lab.
 - Device owners may only use designated electrical outlets fitted with surge protectors to connect up their equipment.
 - Due to limited bandwidth, during peak hours Yellville-Summit School District staff may limit the type of internet use.
 - Any attempt to circumvent Yellville-Summit School District procedures or any unauthorized attempt to access or manipulate Yellville-Summit School District equipment will result in permanent disconnection from the Yellville-Summit School District's Wi-Fi network.
 - If you do not agree to the above terms, please disable your wireless connection or turn off your computer.
